

FOR 25 YEARS, PAMELA YATES, PETER KINOY AND **SKYLIGHT PICTURES HAVE SET A GOLD STANDARD** for elegant, intelligent, hard-hitting documentaries on Latin America. STATE OF FEAR uses the findings of the Peruvian Truth Commission to detail a 20-year reign of terror, beginning in 1980 with the Maoist Shining Path, whose bloody doings were met with equal violence from Peru's democratically elected government. Once the terrorists were subdued, fear of their return was used as an excuse by President Alberto Fujimori to institutionalize absolute power and propagate corruption (revealed to hilarious effect in THE VLADI-VIDEOS). The film transcends its immediate subject to become a

with deadly insurgent groups. Alberto Fujimori, who became president in 1990 — and then dictator — successfully fought terrorists during his ten years in power, but replaced their violence with his own, aided by his spectacularly corrupt henchman, Vladimiro Montesinos. Now Fujimori is on Interpol's Most-Wanted List, charged with murder and corruption. Fleeing to Japan in 2000, he has lived in exile. It is here that filmmaker Ellen Perry interviewed him, the first person to be given such intimate access since his fall from power. Fujimori has announced his intention to return to Peru to run in the April 2006 election.

WOMEN TALK ABOUT RELATIONSHIPS; MEN TALK ABOUT COMPUTERS. What does it take to get a dozen regular guys, ages 32-70, from various backgrounds (a doctor, engineer, human resources consultant, probation officer, cook) to reveal their emotions? DESERT WIND takes them on a 12-day trek in the Tunisian desert, where a psychologist encourages them to talk about everything from what they like and don't like about their bodies to their recollections of childhood and marriage traumas. Against the dramatic, ascetic beauty of golden sand dunes and brilliant skies. these men reveal secrets even they didn't know they had. It's funny and sad, surprisingly moving, and guaranteed to be a lot more interesting than comparing laptops.

A CRACK TEAM OF DEMOCRATIC POLITICAL CONSULTANTS LED BY JAMES CARVILLE strategize for a struggling presidential candidate...in Bolivia. Rachel Boynton's OUR BRAND IS CRISIS is a fascinating, fly-on-the-wall account of the machinations behind the turbulent reelection campaign of Gonzalo Sanchez de Lozada ("Goni"). In a country facing a calamitous economic crisis. Goni — a wealthy businessman who was president in the mid-'90s and who speaks Spanish with an American accent — may not be the fresh face the country seeks. Yet Carville & Co. devise a U.S.style campaign marked by savvy media techniques and negative ads, emphasizing a single, strong message — reintroducing Goni as an appealing brand. The film questions whether democracy is well served anywhere by such campaign tactics.

IN ISLAMIC IRAN, HOW MUCH IS A WOMAN WORTH IN ${f COMPARISON}$ WITH A MAN — and who pays the difference? Faced with the death penalty for killing his girlfriend at age 16. Akbar is moved to an adult prison at 18 to await execution. The maddening intricacies of the Iranian judicial system have farreaching implications in this moving, piercing drama. The only way Akbar's life will be spared is if the victim's family requests clemency. Muslim law stipulates the value of a woman as half that of a man; therefore, the victim's father must pay the difference between the cost of his daughter and the worth of her murderer to justify his death. A tale of vengeance, labyrinthine judicial procedure and the concept of "blood money."

IN CHINESE WITH ENGLISH SUBTITLES SHADOW DISTRIBUTION DURING CHINA'S CULTURAL REVOLUTION (1966-76).

THE BALLETS "RED DETACHMENT OF WOMEN" AND "THE WHITE-HAIRED GIRL" featured ballerinas pirouetting with rifles held aloft and male dancers executing venal landlords. On screen and stage these fiercely propagandistic stories, in which songs praising Mao always seemed to coincide with a glorious sunrise, were termed yang ban xi, and they were the only form of art allowed. Today young Chinese who crowd Starbucks cafes and modern discotheques know little about a world that disappeared decades ago. This Dutch production blends archival footage of the bad old days with interviews with Chinese baby boomers who sometimes wax nostalgic for what was, after all, their version of the '60s.
